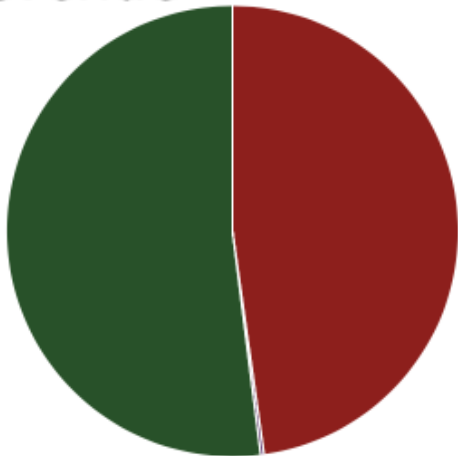

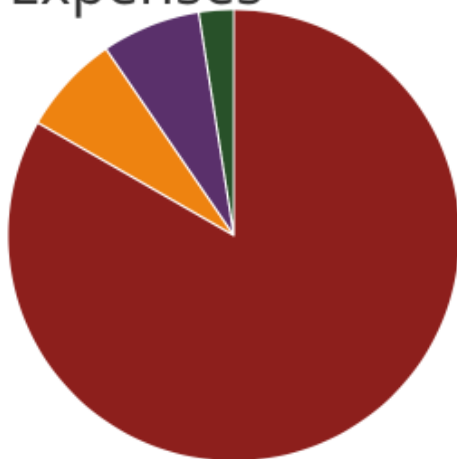
Revenue
